Keynote Speaker: Dr. Joseph Renzulli

Joseph Renzulli is a Distinguished Professor of Educational Psychology at the University of Connecticut and Director of the National Research Center on the Gifted and Talented. His research has focused on strength-based assessment, the identification and development of creativity and giftedness in young people, and models for personalized learning. A focus of his work has been on applying the pedagogy of gifted education to the improvement of learning for all students. The American Psychological Association named Dr. Renzulli among the 25 most influential psychologists in the world and in 2009 he received the Harold W. McGraw, Jr. Award for Innovation in Education, considered by many to be "the Nobel" for educators.



Why S.T.E.A.M.?

Science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics make up the acronym S.T.E.A.M. Although seemingly distinct disciplines, they are in fact united by the innovation and creativity needed to excel in each field. The complex intersections of these disciplines impact learning in and out of classrooms as well as prepare gifted learners for a future world we cannot even imagine. In addition, they define the heart of the Common Core State Standards and what it means to be career-ready and college prepared. This conference explores what it means to go Full S.T.E.A.M. ahead for 21st Century Learning for gifted learners.
